## GIS Database Information Available Geography and Urban-Regional Studies Program Youngstown State University

The following is a list of data layers and documents that exist and are relevant to the project. This is not an exhaustive list, but is meant to convey what is readily available from project partners. Unless otherwise noted, the following data is available from YSU's Geography and Urban-Regional Studies Program:

- Existing land use.
- Existing zoning.
- Redevelopment code, city of Youngstown (I was involved in the drafting of this document and can assist with any questions)
- Property ownership.
- Property tax status and delinquency.
- Youngstown parcel conditions, including vacant structures, 2008-2019.
- Mahoning County vacant lots.
- Existing WRTA routes Need WRTA current GTFS file.
- Existing WRTA stops Need WRTA current GTFS file.
- Existing WRTA shelters.
- Street conditions, lanes, and width, provided by Eastgate and/or ODOT.
- Traffic counts provided by Eastgate.
- Sidewalk locations provided by Eastgate.
- Federal Opportunity Zones.
- Social, economic, and demographic characteristics, from the latest release of the American Community Survey.
- 1,200 ft TOD corridor buffer (or as defined by project) and property and demographic conditions within defined buffer.
- Location of existing activity generators, provided by YSU or Eastgate.
